From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Father, I was wondering... how should I examine my conscience?

Dear Friend, thank you for your great question. Lent is a perfect time to examine our conscience to uncover our sins and weaknesses and work on eliminating them. Ask ourselves... Have I committed any of the following? The 7 capital sins: pride, avarice, lust, anger, gluttony, envy, or sloth? Do I take God's mercy for granted? Do I despair of God's mercy? Do I resist or attack the truths of our faith? Do I envy another person's spiritual good? Do I persist in sin? Do I refuse to repent? Have I committed willful murder, or sodomy? Do I oppress the poor, or defraud laborers of their wages and benefits? Am I an accessory to another person's sin by consent or counsel, or provocation, or silence? Have I committed sins of the flesh? - impurity, jealousy, selfishness, envy, excess drinking or use of drugs. Do I lack humility, or generosity, or chastity, or meekness, or temperance (moderation in the desire for pleasure), or love, or diligence (consistence in doing what is right)? Do I lack faith, hope, or charity? Do I lack prudence, justice, temperance, or fortitude? (To be continued...)
